The Center for Green Schools at USGBC proudly presents the Green Classroom Professional (GCP) certificate program. The GCP certificate program provides pre K-12 educators and school staff with the knowledge to identify what supports or impedes healthy, resource-efficient and environmentally sustainable learning spaces.




CONGRESSIONAL GREEN SCHOOLS CAUCUS
